



HO'OILINA SCHOLARSHIP

2020 Transfer Cohort

The Ho'oilina Scholarship, a partnership between the Hawai'i Tourism Authority (HTA), Hawai'i Lodging and Tourism Association (HLTA), and University of Hawai'i-West O'ahu Business Administration Division will award up to two (2), two-year scholarships (\$8,000 per year) to Hawai'i community college graduates with an associate degree in hospitality, tourism, or culinary studies who enroll at UH West O'ahu and declare Business Administration-Hospitality & Tourism or Applied Science-Culinary Management as their program of study.

Ho'oilina scholarship applications are reviewed by the Ho'oilina Scholarship Selection Committee and are awarded to students who demonstrate high levels of academic achievement and leadership, and express an interest in pursuing a hospitality, tourism or culinary education and career.

SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

- State of Hawai'i resident
- Associate degree in hospitality, tourism, or culinary from Hawai'i community college
- Hawai'i public high school graduate
- 3.3 cumulative GPA

SCHOLARSHIP CONDITIONS*

- 100 hours of community service & service to school
- 200 hours of internship
- Hawaiian culture and/or language classes
- Leadership involvement at UH West O'ahu
- 3.0 cumulative GPA
